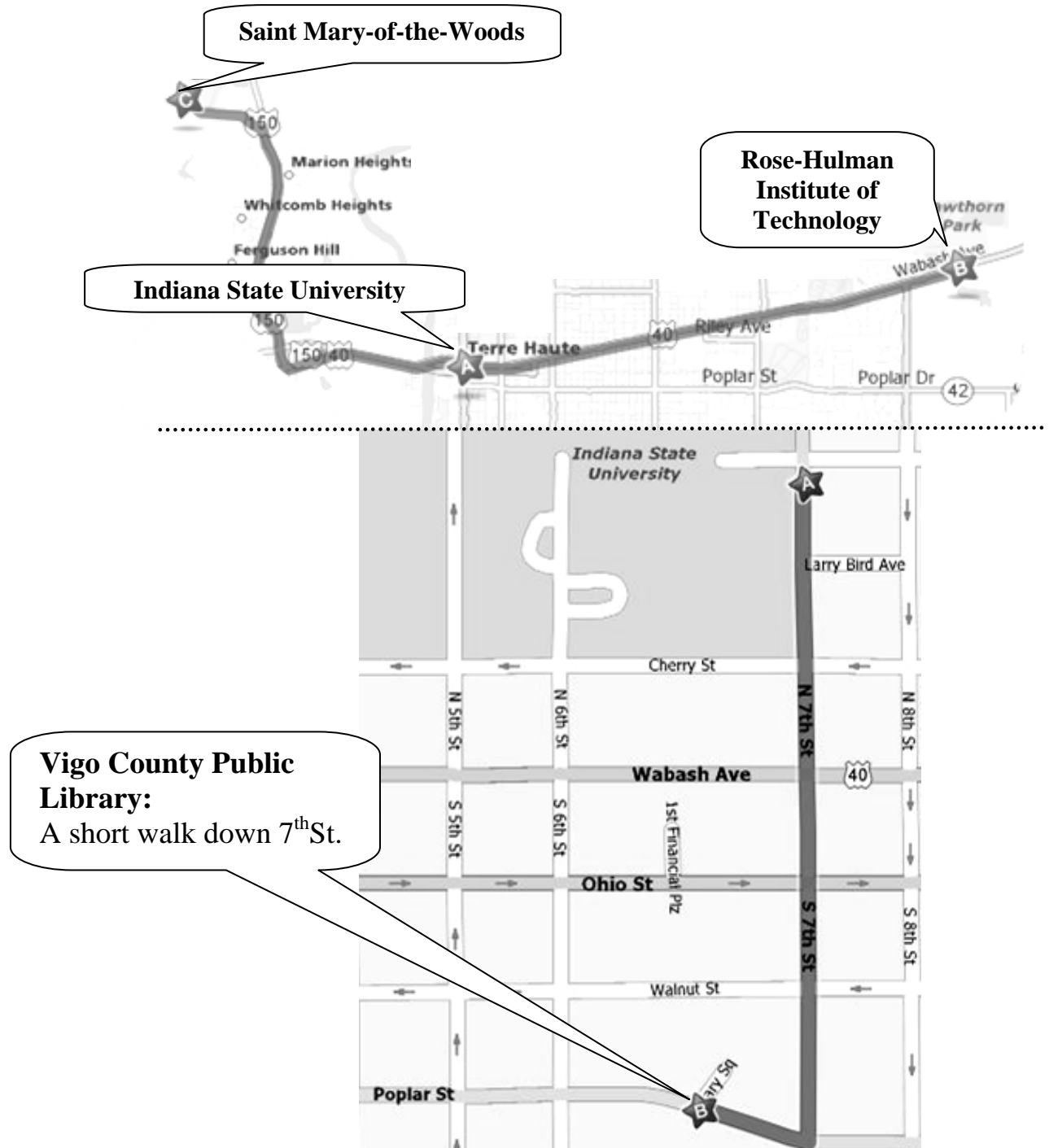

The Rose-Hulman Logan Library shares the library catalog with ISU, St. Mary-of-the-Woods College and Vigo County Public Library. Holdings are mostly science and technology with core collections in social sciences and humanities. **You may check out materials with your ISU ID card.** Book due dates are 30 days for undergraduates, 90 days for graduate students, and 365 days for faculty and staff. You may return borrowed items directly to Rose-Hulman or, if more convenient, ISU Interlibrary Loan can return them for you. ILL will keep a record on file to show what you have returned.

Logan Library research databases may be used while in the Logan Library if you request a temporary guest username and password. Printing is free but users should restrict printing to topics of an educational nature and keep the volume of pages printed to a reasonable amount.

The Logan Library has recently been remodeled! Come see the new look and café with evening hours for late-night study sessions.

The Rose Hulman Campus is about 5 miles from ISU. Drive east from the ISU campus on Wabash Ave/US40. The main entrance to Rose-Hulman is on the left (north) about ½ mile after the stoplight at State Highway 46.

Saint Mary-of-the-Woods (SMWC) shares the library catalog with ISU, Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology, and Vigo County Public Library. **You may check out materials with your ISU ID card.** The loan period for undergraduates is 21 days, for graduate students 89 days, and for faculty 150 days. Books may be renewed in person or through the online catalog. Whatever circulates to SMWC students also circulates to currently affiliated ISU faculty, staff, and students with valid ISU ID cards.

Any database may be used by those visiting the library. Printing is free, but there is a charge for photocopies. Hours may vary when campus classes are not in session.

You may return borrowed items directly to SMWC, or if more convenient, ISU Interlibrary Loan can return them for you. ILL will keep a record on file to show what you have returned.

SMWC now features Jazzman's Café with limited open hours. SMWC is about 5 miles from ISU. Drive west on Wabash Ave (US 40); cross the bridge over the Wabash River into West Terre Haute. Turn right (north) on US 150 and go approx. 2.5 miles. Watch for the St. Mary-of-the-Woods sign on the left side of the road; turn left; drive .7 mile and enter campus at the second gate. Library is on the left, midway in campus.

Vigo County Public Library (VCPL) is just a short walk away from the ISU campus! **You may check out materials after you register for a VCPL library card.** There are various ways for residents and non-residents to qualify for a library card. Please note that if you live off campus in another county, you may not qualify. Call or stop in VCPL to see if you qualify. Once you have the card, you may check out material which include books (21 days), new DVDs (7 days), CDs, older DVDs, games, and videotapes (14 days), and bestseller express books and audio tapes (7 days). You should return borrowed items directly to the VCPL main library.

Other VCPL features are an online book club (receive via e-mail 2-3 chapters from a book), downloadable audio books and videos, and a variety of databases such as consumersreport.com. Special collections include Vigo County records, W.P.A. Indexes, Census Materials, Terre Haute newspapers on microfilm, and other genealogical material.

The main library faces Poplar Street between 6th and 7th Streets, approx. ½ mile south of campus.
